LEAP exists to help ambitious Muslim professionals reconnect faith with everyday life - so that success in this world becomes a means of success in the next.

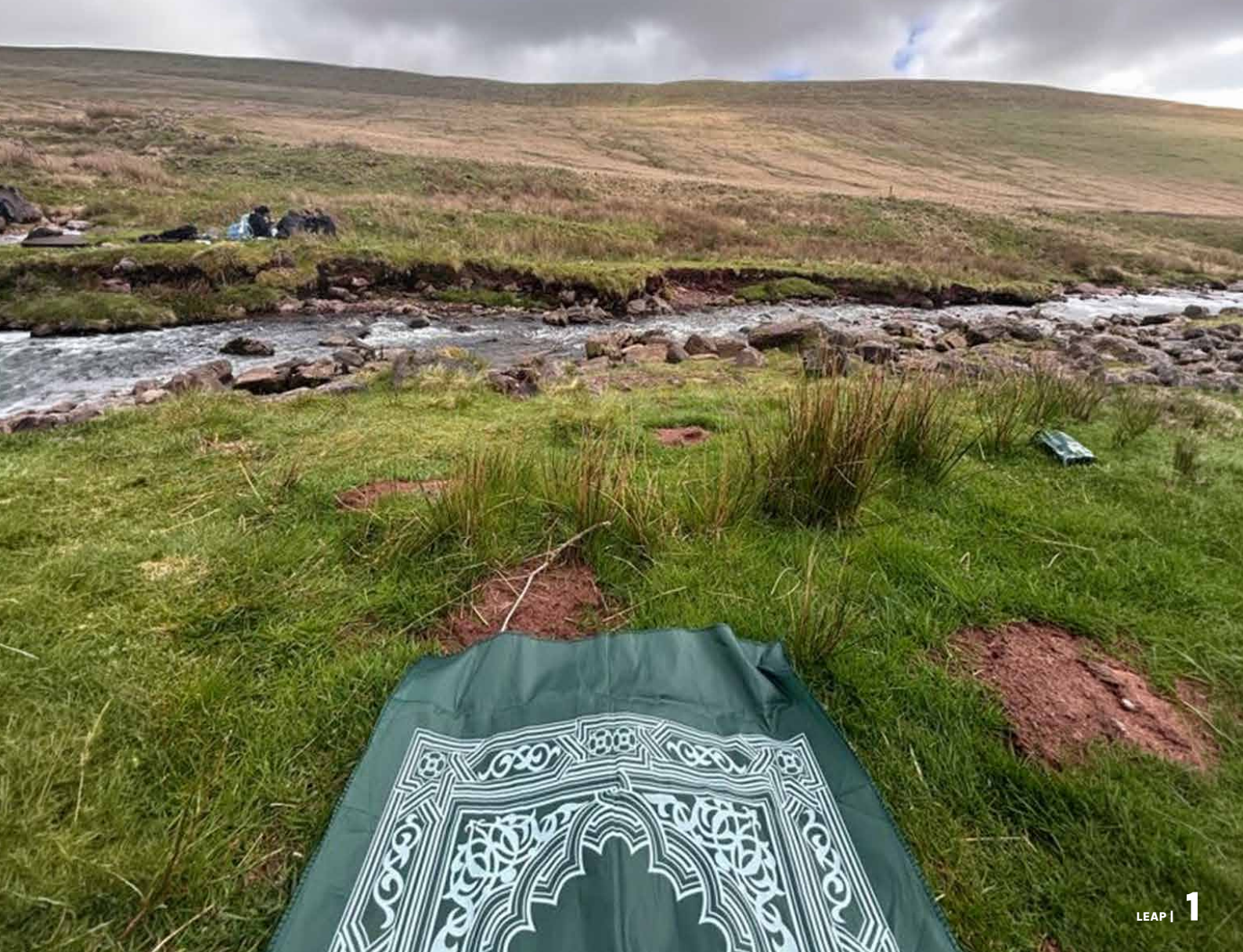
As Muslims, we have a duty to ensure that we live a life that pleases Allah ﷻ, be it in our homes, our places of work, or within our communities.

WHY JOIN LEAP?

LEAP is a Muslim professional development programme designed to help professionals draw closer to Allah ﷻ and serve as effective leaders through knowledge-based workshops, skills development, experiential learning & adventure.

LEAP provides access to scholars, academics and thinkers in a close, interactive environment. It promotes critical thinking and prioritises living life with a higher purpose.

WHO IS THIS FOR?

This programme is for Muslim professionals who wish to deepen their understanding of Islam while exploring the everyday challenges and opportunities facing Muslims today. Whatever your profession, educational background, or stage in your journey as a Muslim, you are warmly welcome.



WHAT'S ON OFFER?

The programme will have three components:

The Sessions:

Sessions occur once a fortnight with breaks including Ramadan. Each session is an introduction to an Islamic science or based on leadership development. Further reading is suggested should you wish to explore a topic further. There may be pre-reading or preparation work to complete alongside end-of-session reflections. This is directed by our instructors to ensure that participants get full value out of sessions.

Sessions involve a hybrid delivery. If you're unable to attend in person, you can join online via Zoom or catch up with a recording of the session at your convenience. We strongly encourage in person and/or live online attendance (where applicable) to maximise benefit and allow building deeper friendships and camaraderie with the rest of the LEAP cohort.



The Retreat:

Spend a weekend in Dorset with our instructors filled with spiritual reminders, outdoor activities and workshops exploring prophetic leadership.



Challenges:

Spend a day hiking with your fellow participants, witnessing Allah's blessings whilst pushing yourself and those around you.

International trip

Spend 5 days abroad on an international challenge with our charity partner, exploring the beautiful landscapes and visiting the project that you will be fundraising for.

23 Sept 2026	Living with the Quran - An Introduction to Ulmul Quran	- What makes the Quran a miracle in structure and history? - How can understanding its compilation deepen my connection to it?
07 Oct 2026	Leadership Stories from the Quran	- What leadership qualities are demonstrated by key figures in the Quran? - What lessons can I derive from this, and how can I apply them to my life?
23-25 Oct 2026	Prophetic Leadership Retreat	- Do I see myself as a leader? - How do I measure against prophetic qualities? - What leadership styles suit specific contexts? - How do I lead change whilst staying true to my Muslim identity?
04 Nov 2026	Seerah: the life of the Prophet ﷺ	- What are the key events in the life of the Prophet Muhammad ﷺ? - What lessons can I draw from his life as inspiration for my own?
18 Nov 2026	Time with Barakah - How to Achieve More with Less	- How can I increase the barakah in my time? - How can I learn to work smarter?
02 Dec 2026	Reflection Session (REMOTE)	- An opportunity to share learning and application of Prophetic Leadership Qualities amongst fellow participants.

How can I lead with balance and integrity? - Why is duaah important, and what etiquette underpins duaah? - What is holding me back from a deeper connection with duaah?
27 Jan 2027	Community Social	- An opportunity to build connections and reflect on the journey so far.
13 Feb 2027	Faith Inspire Community Iftar	- An opportunity to break fast with fellow participants and the wider Faith Inspire family.
10 Mar 2027	Living with the Sunnah: An Introduction to Hadith Sciences	- What is a hadith and why is it considered primary evidence in Islam? - How were hadith classified and verified?
24 Mar 2027	Navigating Difficult Conversations	- How can I handle difficult conversations with wisdom?
03 Apr 2027	Hike	- Spend the day in nature reflecting on gratitude and resilience.

06 July 2027	International Challenge	- Work together for a legacy project. - Learn from history and enjoy an adventure of a lifetime. - Provide feedback and reflection on the programme.
17 July 2027	Graduation Celebration	- Celebrate with food, family and gratitude.

A certificate will be awarded to participants for completion of the programme at a celebration event. In order to receive a certificate, minimum attendance and evidence of participation is required.

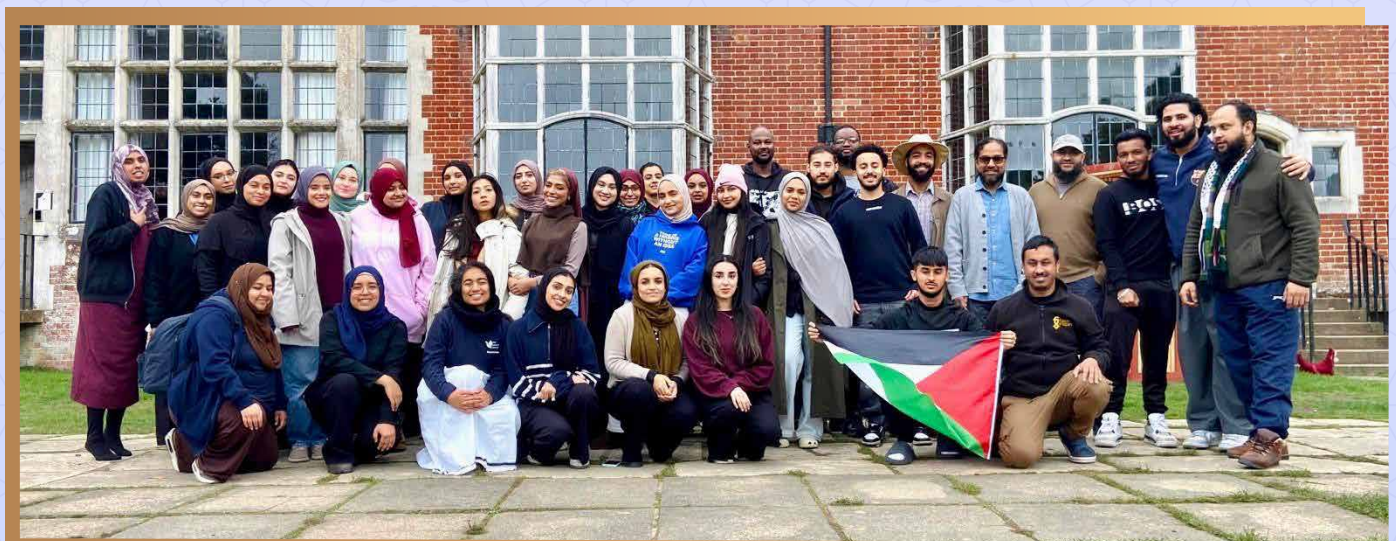
ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES
